### Second Cook (Base Salary \$36,921-\$37,730)

Second Cooks are responsible to clean, prepare, and cook in accordance with planned menus, assuring meals are fresh and hot at serving time. Assist with baking duties; prepare night lunches and box lunches for field parties. Maintains mess and galley, food preparation equipment, storage areas and cooking equipment in a clean, orderly and sanitary condition including washing dishes, silver, pots, pans, and glassware; disposes of galley and mess garbage. Assist in estimating provisions; assist in purchases and inventory of stores. Prepare tables for meals and cleans up after meals. Second Cook will perform laundry duties as directed.

Possess a current and valid United States Coast Guard Merchant Mariners Credential endorsed with:

- Entry Level ratings - OS, Wiper, Steward Utilityman (FH)

Applicant must possess one (1) year of experience:

- Serving meals, cleaning galley messes. General cooking and baking, food preparation. (Restaurant or shipboard experience).

Applicant must possess Food Protection Manager Certificate or equivalent within the last three years.

### General Vessel Assistant (Base Salary \$33,187-\$33,914)

General Vessel Assistants (GVA) performs work in the Deck, Engine and Steward Departments. In the Steward Department, incumbent will be washing dishes, preparing tables and cleaning galley and mess deck.
