

Motorboat Operator Certification Course

- This 24 hour course was developed by the Department of the Interior, but is applicable to NOAA small boat Operators. It reviews minimum requirements for safe operation of motorboats and includes a review of legal requirements, preparations, navigation, operations, emergency procedures, rescue, self rescue, trailering, fire suppression and basic seamanship.

- PQS Assessment on policy (updated annually referencing new policy)
- Seamanship every 3 years, SBO w/ USCG License are exempt
- NOAA Component Refresher Training every 3 years
- Additional notes: VOC Handbook is being revised

Training Goals


How can I as a VOC or VPC create Training Goals

- Short Term Training Plans Routine training, such as drills. Have them available for viewing for all to see. This can align with new SB Operator PQS sign offs.
- Long Term Training Plans This type of training involves planning, such as PQS refresher training, CPR training, recertification training.
- Being organized and creating efficient training plans = Achieving Training Goals.
- Plan ahead and create a safe training environment using all available resources to make it work.
