What's New

- 1. <u>Bloodborne Pathogen Awareness 2.0</u>: Required SBP Operator training every 2 years in coordination with First Aid, CPR and AED Training.
- 2. <u>Small Boat Standards and Procedures Manual Policy Test (SBP)</u>: Required SBP Operator and Crewman refresher training every 3 years in coordination with Personal Qualification Standards "PQS".
- 3. <u>NOAA Small Boat Component Course Refresher Test (SBP)</u>: Recommended SBP Operator and Crewman refresher training every 3 years in coordination with Personal Qualification Standards "PQS".
